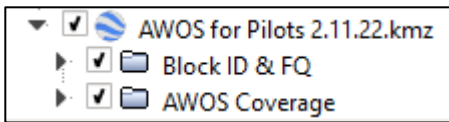


Gulf of Mexico

AWOS for Pilots Guide Sheet

The KML file provided contains the FAA Approved AWOS sites and coverage. This file can be imported to flight planning software and Google Earth.

File Structure: The *AWOS for Pilots* file is named with the issue date and is organized into two folders.



- *AWOS Coverage* shows the Offshore Weather Deviation Areas / Weather Boxes
- *Block ID & FQ* shows AWOS location and site details

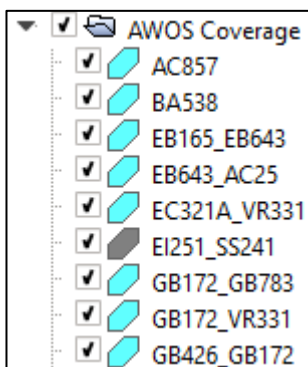
Block ID & FQ

- AWOS locations are named by the Block ID and AWOS frequency
- Platform Name, Owner, AWOS telephone number, and a link to the METAR History is in the Description/Details field



AWOS Coverage

- Weather Boxes are named by the Block IDs of the sites that form the coverage
- Permanently Approved Weather Boxes have alternating blue and orange outlines and blue fill.
- Provisionally Approved Weather Boxes have a black outline and yellow fill (*report discrepancies to FAA Gulf Team*)
