### **AVIATION SPECTRUM RESOURCES BRIEFING** (Attachment 2)

- Andrew Roy of Aviation Spectrum Resources, Inc. (ASRI), began his presentation with a brief overview of ASRI and the Aeronautical Frequency Committee (AFC)
- Mr. Roy then briefed the membership on the Ligado proposal to the FCC.
- ASRI along with other aviation signatories filed comments on May 23, August 11, and August 21, 2016, expressing concerns with the proposal
- The biggest concerns with the Ligado proposal involves four area:
  - Certified GPS Separation limits, handsets, implementation process
  - o Non-certified GPS Testing of existing receivers, level of impact
  - o SATCOM
    - INMARSAT Unknown impact, information from other studies
    - IRIDIUM Handset interference, no agreement possible
  - NOAA Satellite downlinks weather balloons, satellite images, advisories from Hurricane Center, Storm Prediction Center, Lightning Data, and AIRMETS & SIGMETS.
    - The are issues with technical studies
    - There is no protection for non-NOAA users
    - Limited details of the internet replacement proposal
